

# Clinic Consultation Checklist

Use this before and during every clinic consultation. Going in prepared means you'll spot red flags, compare quotes fairly, and avoid the mistakes that lead to bad outcomes.

## Before You Book

- Verify the surgeon's credentials and specialisation in hair restoration
- Check independent reviews (not just the clinic's own website)
- Ask if the surgeon personally performs extraction and implantation
- Confirm how many procedures the surgeon performs per day
- Review before/after photos of real patients with similar hair loss stages
- Ensure the quote covers all costs — no surprise extras on the day

## Key Questions to Ask

- How many grafts exactly? Get a written number, not 'around' a figure
- Who performs the surgery — the surgeon you consult, or technicians?
- What technique will you use, and why is it right for my hair type?
- What is my donor capacity? Do I have enough for the density promised?
- What happens if I lose more hair — does the plan account for future loss?
- What is the touch-up policy if density is uneven after healing?
- What are the realistic risks? A good surgeon will be honest.

## Red Flags to Watch For

- Clinic won't confirm the surgeon's name before you arrive
- Quote promises an unusually high graft count at a suspiciously low price
- Pressure to book immediately or lose a 'special price'
- Before/after photos with no patient details or that look like stock images
- Technicians — not the surgeon — performing most of the procedure
- No written breakdown of exactly what is included in the price

## Signs of a Good Clinic

- Surgeon performs the consultation AND the surgery personally
- Honest about what density is achievable — not just telling you what you want to hear
- Discusses future hair loss and long-term donor preservation
- Has real patient photos with documented graft counts and time since surgery
- Provides a written treatment plan before you commit to anything
- Limits daily procedures so your surgery gets full attention
